

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer of the State shall, on the warrant of the Comptroller, disburse the said sums of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes herein specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons, or bodies politic or corporate entitled to receive the same.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect on and after the first day of October, eighteen hundred and eighty-two.

### Chapter 433.

AN ACT to repeal chapter one hundred and thirty-seven of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled "An act to repeal section sixty-nine of article one of the Public Local Laws," entitled "Allegany County," sub-title "Fences," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That chapter one hundred and thirty-seven (137) of the acts of the General Assembly, January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, (1870) entitled "An act to repeal section sixty-nine (69) of article one of the Public Local Laws," entitled "Allegany county," sub-title "Fences," and to re-enact the same with amendments, be repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed and  
re-enacted.

SECTION 69. It shall not be lawful for any person in Allegany county to impound any horned or black cattle, horses, sheep or hogs, unless the same shall be found trespassing within an inclosure enclosed by a good and substantial fence at least four and one-half feet high.

When lawful

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
