Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That upon the production of the said justice's certificate before the County Commissioners of St. Mary's county, the commissioners are hereby authorized and directed to levy upon the assessable property of St. Mary's county, a sum sufficient for the aforesaid bounties for the use of the person or persons producing the same, and the collector of the taxes shall collect and pay the same accordingly.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That this act shall Effective. take effect from and after the date of its passage.

Chapter 34.

AN ACT to grant certain leave of absence, with pay, to the Officers, Patrolmen and Detectives constituting the Police Force of the city of Baltimore.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Board of Police Commissioners for the city of Baltimore be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to grant leave of absence, with pay, for a period of seven days in each consecutive year of service to each of the officers of police, policemen and detectives of the regular force employed by said board; nor shall any enforced absence, with leave on account of sickness or death, be deducted from the pay of said officer of police, policemen or detectives, or from the seven days' leave herein provided.
