

Chapter 436.

AN ACT to provide for the Payment of Costs in Appeals from the Registers of Voters for the Aldermanic Districts of Frederick City.

Appeals from
officers of reg-
istration.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the costs incurred in appeals from the decision of any officer of registration for the Aldermanic district of Frederick city, in which the Circuit Court for Frederick county or any judge thereof has directed, or may order the party taking such appeal to be registered, shall be paid by the Mayor and Aldermen of Frederick city.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

AN ACT to incorporate the "Choptank and Blackwater Canal and Land Improvement Company."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Edwin H. Dashfield, Dr. William R. Hayward, Daniel M. Henry, William Wilson, Byron Clement Sullivan, Lazarus Powell, Edward W. Lecompt, James H. Eccleston, William Wilson Dail, Alfred J. Mowbray, Charles H. Seward, James Wallace, Joseph H. Johnson, Lebulon Mitchell, David Straughan, William H. Hopkins, Henry W. Straughan and Thomas C. Eaton be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to open books and receive subscriptions to the capital stock of the company hereby incorporated, and the said commissioners, or any five of them, shall fix the time and place of securing such subscriptions, and shall continue said books open to secure subscriptions so long as they may deem necessary to complete the trust.
