

## Chapter 454.

AN ACT to repeal sections thirty-five, thirty-six, thirty-eight and thirty-nine of article nine of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Charles County," sub-title "County Commissioners," and sections forty-eight and forty-nine of the same article, sub-title "Jurors," and to re-enact the same with amendments, to fix and provide for the pay of jurors, witnesses, bailiffs, messengers and criers of the Circuit Court for Charles county, to appoint an officer to disburse the same and to authorize the County Commissioners of Charles county to borrow not exceeding five thousand dollars to pay arrearages for expenses already incurred by the attendance of jurors, State's witnesses, bailiffs, messengers and criers at the Circuit Court for said county, and to pay said expenses for the balance of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections thirty-five, thirty-six, thirty-eight and thirty-nine of article nine of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Charles county," sub-title "County Commissioners," and sections forty-eight and forty-nine of the same article, sub-title "Jurors" be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 35. They shall annually appoint a clerk, who, in addition to his other duties, shall act as treasurer of said county, as hereinafter provided in sections thirty-six, thirty-eight and thirty-nine of this article, and shall be liable to removal by the said commissioners, who shall fill any vacancy in the said office at their next meeting thereafter, or as soon as practicable.

Appoint clerk.

SECTION 36. The said clerk and treasurer shall give bond to the State of Maryland, to be approved by the judges of the Circuit Court for Charles county, or a majority of said judges, during recess,
