

pay over the said sums so levied prior to the time when the same may be demandable by the said treasurer may be proceeded against in accordance with the provisions of the preceding section, and be subject to its provisions and penalties.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act be and the same are to that extent hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 455.

AN ACT to extend the powers of the bailiff of the town of St. Michaels, in Talbot county.

Powers of
bailiff extend-
ed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the bailiff of the town of St. Michaels, in Talbot county, be authorized and empowered to act as a conservator of the peace in any part of said county to execute all criminal process in any part of said county which may be directed to him by any justice of the peace or other officer of said county authorized to issue such process, and for such service aforesaid shall receive such fees as the constables of the county now receive in such cases, payable by the county commissioners.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.
