which the said volumes may be printed, in accordance with the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, chapter four hundred and ten, three hundred and fifty dollars for each volume, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

MILITIA.

For the support of the Militia of the State, to be expended under the supervision of the Governor, under the provisions of the act of eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter one hundred and eighty two, thirteen thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be distributed as follows, to wit: For salary of the Adjutant General, fifteen hundred dollars; for the incidental exexpenses of the Adjutant General's office, five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for the support of the twenty-three Military Companies now in existence, four hundred and fifty dollars each, to be expended under the approval of the Governor and Commander in Chief, upon the requisition of the Company Commander, approved by battalion and brigade commanders; and to the headquarters of each battalion and brigade, two hundred and fifty dollars each, or so much thereof as may be necessary, and the additional sum of four hundred and fifty dollars is hereby appropriated for the Williamsport Light Infantry.

PENSIONS.

For the payment of pensions granted by various acts and resolutions of the General Assembly, one thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

SCHOOLS.

For the system of free public schools, white and colored, in the several counties and the city of Baltimore, and for the State Normal School and the State Board of Education, to be apportioned by the Comptroller in accordance with the law in such case made and provided and the directions herein given, five hundred thousand dollars, or whatever sum may be paid into the treasury on account of the tax for public schools, also such other sum or sums as
