INCIDENTAL EXPENSES OF THE VARIOUS STATE OFFICES.

For the expenses of the Treasury Department for advertising, stationery, blank books, expressage, telegrams and other incidental expenses, two thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for the expenses of the Comptroller's Office, for printing blanks, licenses, protests, circulars, warrants, books and office expenses, three thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for the traveling expenses of the State Tax Commissioner, eight hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

To pay the members and officers of the General Assembly, including postage, stationery, mileage and miscellaneous expenses, as follows, to wit: For the per diem of the President of the Senate, at eight dollars per day, seven hundred and twenty dollars; for the per diem of twenty-five Senators, at five dollars per day, eleven thousand two hundred and fifty dollars; for the per diem of one Secretary to the Senate, at ten dollars per day, nine hundred dollars; for the per diem of one Reading Clerk of the Senate, at ten dollars per day, nine hundred dollars; for the per diem of one Journal Clerk of the Senate, at ten dollars per day, nine hundred dollars; for the per diem of one Sergeant-at-Arms of the Senate, at five dollars per day, four hundred and fifty dollars; for the per diem of one Doorkeeper to the Senate, at five dollars per day, four hundred and fifty dollars; for the per diem of one Assistant Doorkeeper to the Senate, at five dollars per day, four hundred and fifty dollars; for the per
