Chapter 39.

AN ACT to extend and supplement an act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter three hundred and twenty-eight, entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Baltimore Steam Packet Company," and also to extend and supplement an act passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-six, chapter fifteen, entitled "An Act to extend the Charter of the Baltimore Steam Packet Company."

Preamble.

WHEREAS by an act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter three hundred and twenty-eight, the Baltimore Steam Packet Company was incorporated with a provision that said act should continue in force until the year eighteen hundred and sixty-two, and until the end of the next session of the General Assembly thereafter; and whereas, by an act passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-six, chapter fifteen, said act of eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter three hundred and twenty-eight, was extended and continued in full force for the period of twenty years from the tenth day of March, eighteen hundred and sixty-two, and until the end of the next session of the General Assembly thereafter; and whereas, it is desirable that the provisions of said acts shall be continued in full force, therefore:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the corporate rights, privileges and franchises granted by said act of assem-
