

bly, entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Baltimore Steam Packet Company," passed at the December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter three hundred and twenty-eight, and also by the act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-six, chapter fifteen, be and the same are hereby continued in full force for the period of forty years from the passage of this act, and until the end of the session of the General Assembly which shall convene next thereafter, and with full power to said corporation to acquire, purchase, hold and dispose of the stocks, bonds or obligations of other corporations.

Corporate rights continued.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That said corporation shall have full power to enlarge its capital stock, when advisable in the opinion of a majority of its stockholders, and to issue bonds or other evidences of debt to such an extent and in such form as may be approved of by a majority of its stockholders, and the same to secure by mortgage or otherwise; said increase of stock, however, not to exceed in amount the sum of two million and five hundred thousand dollars.

Enlarge capital stock.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the principal office of said corporation shall be in the city of Baltimore, or at such other place as the President and Board of Directors shall from time to time designate.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

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**Chapter 40.**

AN ACT to give the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to a certain bequest in the last will and testament of Matilda Shafer, late of Frederick county, deceased, to the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Frederick.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sanction is hereby given to the bequest of fifty dollars to the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Frederick, of which Rev. George
