

**Chapter 479.**

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of C. Boessel.

Issue warrant.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer to pay to C. Boessel, for repairs to the clocks for the Senate and House of Delegates, and for locks and keys furnished and repairs, one hundred and two dollars and thirty cents.

Effective.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

**Chapter 480.**

AN ACT to repeal an act entitled "An act in relation to mendicant and vagrant children," being chapter three hundred and ninety-two of the acts of assembly of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-six, and to re-enact the same in an amended form.

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That chapter three hundred and ninety-two of the acts of assembly of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-six, entitled "An act in relation to mendicant and vagrant children," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted in an amended form so as to read as follows, viz.:

Custody or control.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That any person having in his care, custody or control any child under the age of sixteen years, whether as parent, guardian, relative, employer or otherwise, who shall sell, apprentice, give away, let out or otherwise dispose of any such child to any person under any name, title or pretence whatever, and any person, whether
