

**Chapter 43.**

AN ACT to repeal sub-section one of an act passed at the January session of the General Assembly of Maryland, eighteen hundred and seventy two, chapter three hundred and eighty-nine, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to article twenty-one of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled 'Washington County,' sub-title 'Williamsport,' to come in after section three hundred and thirty-one of said article, and also to repeal section three hundred and thirty-two of said article, 'And re-enact the same with Amendments,'" and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows :

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sub-section one of an act passed at the January session of the General Assembly of Maryland, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter three hundred and eighty-nine, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to article twenty-one of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled 'Washington County,' sub-title 'Williamsport,' to come in after section three hundred and thirty-two of said article, and re-enact the same with amendments," be and the same is hereby repealed and is re-enacted so as to read as follows :

SUB-SECTION 1. The Burgess and Commissioners of the Town of Williamsport, or a majority of them for the time being, be and they are hereby authorized, at any time within five years after the passage of this act, to levy a tax on all the taxable property within the corporate limits of said town, not exceeding twenty-five cents on each one hundred dollars' worth of said property, to raise a fund for the purpose of erecting a suitable police station house in said town, to be collected as other corporation taxes are now collected in said town; and the said Burgess and Commissioners, or a majority of them, are hereby authorized to contract for and superintend the building of said police station house, and to use the said fund or so much thereof as may be necessary to
