

Chapter 498.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of Jacob H. Medairy & Co., for stationery furnished for the use of the General Assembly, the Executive Department and the Court of Appeals.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the State Treasurer to pay Jacob H. Medairy & Co., for stationery furnished for the use of the General Assembly for this present session, for the Executive Department and the Court of Appeals, the sum of five thousand two hundred and thirty-three dollars and eighty-five cents.

Who to pay to.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 499.

AN ACT to appropriate six hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the payment of counsel and of the costs in the cases of certain officers of registration whose cases were heard and tried before United States Commissioner Bond, and in the Circuit Court of the United States for the district of Maryland, in November and December, eighteen hundred and eighty, and March, eighteen hundred and eighty-one.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of six hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated to the payment of counsel and costs in the cases of certain officers of
