Lee, of Anne Arundel county, one of which cases was heard before United States Commissioner Bond, and the other tried in the Circuit Court of the United States for the district of Maryland; four hundred dollars of which sum shall be paid to S. Thomas McCullough, counsel for the said officers of registration, and two hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be applied to the payment of the costs in the said cases of the said officers of registration; and the said respective sums, so hereby respectively appropriated and directed to be paid, shall be paid to the parties entitled to receive the same, by the Treasurer of this State, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, which said warrant the said Comptroller is hereby directed to draw in favor of the parties so entitled to receive the same; this claim has been presented to the Comptroller, together with the proofs upon which the same is founded, and reported upon by him.
