Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given to the said bequest contained in the aforesaid last will and testament of Thomas Butler, late of Frederick county, deceased, to the said Saint John's Catholic Church in Frederick City, Maryland.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall

take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 46.

AN ACT to repeal chapter three hundred and seventy-three of the acts passed January session, eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact chapter four hundred and thirty-nine of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled 'An Act to regulate the issuing licenses for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in this State,'" and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That chapter three hundred and seventy-three of the acts passed January session, eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact chapter four hundred and thirty-nine, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled 'An Act to regulate the issuing of licenses for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in this State,'" be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Section 1. From and after the passage of this act it shall not be lawful for the clerks of Circuit Courts of this State to issue any license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer to any person or body politic in this State, unless such person or body politic shall have been recommended to the clerks by the grand jury which shall have been in session at the term next preceding the first
