Joint resolution in relation to a survey by the General Government of the Wicomico river of this State.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,
That the Senators and Representatives of this State in the Congress of the United States be and they are hereby requested to introduce and press the passage of a resolution through their bodies, requiring the War Department to cause a survey of the Wicomico river in this State, from its mouth to the town of Salisbury, to be made with a view to the improvement of navigation of said river, and an estimate of the cost of such improvement.
