

day of May in each and every year in the county where the applicant for such license shall reside; provided, however, that this act or any of its provisions shall not apply to Baltimore city, Frederick, Baltimore, Prince George, Alleghany, Somerset, Carroll, Howard, Washington, Wicomico, St. Mary's, Harford, Dorchester, Cecil, Anne Arundel, Montgomery and Caroline counties; and provided, nevertheless, that the clerk of the Circuit Court for Charles county is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to issue license for one year from the time of application therefor, for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, to Joseph Henry, Samuel Henry and Anthony Mortinez, trading under the firm name and style of Henry Brothers & Co., at Cedar Point, in the aforesaid county.

Where not to apply.

Issue license for one year.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the passage of this act be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

Inconsistent acts repealed.

**Chapter 47.**

AN ACT to permit the Baltimore Union Passenger Railway Company to lay its tracks upon certain streets in the city of Baltimore, with the consent of the Mayor and City Council, and to lease and operate the lines of other railway companies.

WHEREAS the Baltimore Union Passenger Railway Company, a corporation incorporated under the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter two hundred and forty-two, has duly become vested with all the rights and franchises granted by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore by ordinance number one hundred and fifty, approved twenty-fifth day October, eighteen hundred and eighty, therefore—
