Chapter 49.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact as amended the twenty-first and twenty-fifth sections of the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter three hundred and forty, entitled "An Act to repeal an act of the Legislature passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter four hundred and six, entitled 'An Act to repeal sections one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, title 'Baltimore County,' sub-title twenty. 'Roads,' passed at the January session of the Legislature of eighteen hundred and seventyfour, chapter two hundred and seventy-four, and to re-enact the same with amendments," and to enact the following in lieu thereof, and to add two additional sections thereto relating to avenues and roads in Baltimore county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the twenty-first and twenty-fifth sections of the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter three hundred and forty, be and the same is hereby repealed, and re-enacted so that the same shall read as follows:

Section 21. And be it enacted, That whenever any bridge may need, in the opinion of the County Commissioners, any repairs, they shall have power to order that such repairs shall be made under the direction of the Road Commissioners of the district.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter three hundred and forty, be amended by the addition of the following sections, to wit: That whenever any owner or owners of property in Baltimore county have opened, laid out, or graded any avenue or avenues, road or roads for the public convenience, and are willing to dedicate the same to public uses by good and sufficient deed or deeds duly recorded, the said County Commissioners are hereby author-
