

**Chapter 63.**

AN ACT to repeal section five, article twenty four, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Conveyancing," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section five, article twenty-four, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Conveyancing," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows :

Repealed and re-enacted.

**SECTION 5.** If acknowledged without the United States, the acknowledgment may be made before : First, any minister, consul general, consul, deputy consul, vice consul, consular agent, consular officer of the United States ; second, any notary public ; third, a commissioner of this State to take acknowledgments of deeds.

Before whom made.

**SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

**Chapter 64.**

AN ACT to repeal section forty-six of article eighty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Sheriffs," sub-title "Collection of Officers' Fees," so far as the same relates to Harford county.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section forty-six of article eighty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Sheriffs," sub-title "Collection of Officers' Fees," so far as the same relates to Harford county, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Repealed.

**SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
