Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section five, article twenty-four, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Conveyancing," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

Section 5. If acknowledged without the United States, the acknowledgment may be made before: First, any minister, consul general, consul, deputy consul, vice consul, consular agent, consular officer of the United States; second, any notary public; third, a commissioner of this State to take ac-

Chapter 64.
