AN ACT to amend the third section of article thirty-three of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the Indigent Blind.

Repealed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the third section of article thirty-three of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to Indigent Blind, be and the same is hereby repealed, and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

3. A sum not exceeding nine thousand thousand dollars shall be annually appropriated, to be applied under the direction of the Governor, in placing for instruction in the Maryland Institution for the instruction of the Blind, or in some convenient institution established for the purpose, such Indigent Blind persons of the age of nine years and upwards, inhabitants of this State, and the county or city from which they are recommended, as may be duly recommended to the Governor by the county commissioners of each county, and by the judges of the Orphans' court of Baltimore city.
