

CHAPTER 93.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the Commissioner of the Land Office to issue a patent for a tract of land called "Saint Barts." Passed Feb. 6, 1866.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Commissioner of the Land Office is hereby authorised and directed to issue a patent for a tract of land called "Saint Barts," to John A. Smith. Authorized to issue patent.

Sec. 2. *Be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 94.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT to the act of eighteen hundred and sixty, chapter two hundred and seventy-four, entitled, an Act to incorporate the Baltimore and Liberty Turnpike Company. Passed Feb. 6, 1866.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the said Baltimore and Liberty Turnpike Company, shall have full power and authority to borrow or raise by loan, a sum of money not exceeding twenty thousand dollars, for the purpose of liquidating any debt or debts they may have contracted in the construction of their said Turnpike Road, and to secure the payment of the same by a mortgage or pledge of their said road and property owned by them, and their tolls, privileges and corporate franchises in such manner as the president and directors of said Company may deem proper. Authorised to borrow money.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said Turnpike Company shall have power and authority to sell and convey a certain lot of land situated in Power to sell.
