CHAPTER 95.

Passed Feb. 6, 1866. AN ACT to amend an act passed at January Session, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter three hundred and seventy-nine, entitled, "An Act to amend An Act to incorporate the Mutual Insurance Company of Washington county," passed at December Session, eighteen hundred and forty-five, chapter thirty-seven, and to extend the charter of said company.

Amended. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the fourth section of the act, passed at January Session, in year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter three hundred and seventy-nine, entitled, an act to amend an act entitled an act to incorporate the Mutual Insurance Company of Washington county, passed at December Session, eighteen hundred and forty-five, chapter thirty-seven, shall be altered and amended as follows: strike out all after the word "credits," in the eighth line of said section four, and **Provisoes.** insert in lieu thereof the words, "*provided*, that no dividend shall be made except of the net profits, exceeding the sum of twenty thousand dollars; *and provided, further*, when each annual dividend is made after the adoption of this act by the members
