

CHAPTER 101.

Passed Feb. 7, 1866. AN ACT to aid in the re-organization of St. John's College.

Preamble. WHEREAS, The visitors and governors of St. John's College have had restored to them the College building and premises, which have been occupied by the Federal Government, since October eighteen hundred and sixty-one, for military purposes, and are about to resume their collegiate course of instruction therein; Therefore,

Authorized to pay. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the conditions annexed to the several appropriations for the payment of the annuity of three thousand dollars to that college contained in the several general appropriation bills heretofore passed be and the same are hereby repealed, and the Treasurer upon the warrant of the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to the order of the said visitors and governors these suspended appropriations.

Additional payment. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the Treasurer on the warrant of the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorised and directed in addition to the sum of three thousand dollars, now annually paid to the said visitors and governors, to pay to their order the sum of twelve thousand dollars annually, on and after the first day of June eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, for and during the term of five years.

In force. Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
