

any note, token, device, scrip, or other evidence of debt to be used as currency.

Sec. 7. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from and after its passage, but nothing herein contained shall authorize the said company to go into operation until at least one hundred shares are subscribed, of one hundred dollars each, and ten dollars on each share paid in. ^{To take effect.}

Sec. 8. *And be it enacted*, That the General Assembly reserves to itself the right to alter, amend, or repeal this Act at pleasure. ^{Reservation.}

CHAPTER 124.

AN ACT to incorporate the Allegany Vine Growing, Manufacturing and Agricultural Association. ^{Passed Jan. 8, 1866.}

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly* ^{Incorporated.} of Maryland, That Charles Young, William Ambruster, George Reisoheilm, C. H. Orr, Henry Bloomenour, Jno. R. Crusen, John F. Johnson, Jas. A. Furguson, George W. Hoover, Joseph H. Ways, and such other persons as may become associated with them in manner as hereinafter provided, be and they are hereby made and constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of the [of the] Allegany Vine Growing, Manufacturing and Agricultural Association, and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and be able to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded in any court whatever, and may have a common seal, and the same alter and renew at pleasure, and the said association shall have all the powers, faculties, franchises and rights necessary or convenient for carrying on the raising of grapes and other agricultural productions, and for manufacturing and preparing the same for use and sale, and for mining and manufacturing the minerals, ores and other products of its property, and selling and disposing of
