CHAPTER 125.

AN ACT to repeal the forty-second and fifty-sixth Passed Feb 8, 1866. sections, of the fourteenth article, of the Public Local Laws, relating to Chestertown, under the title of "Kent county," empowering the commissioners of said town to make by-laws, to prevent and remove nuisances, impose fines and forfeitures, and to collect the same, and for the appointment of a Supervisor, and to re-enact the said sections with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the forty-second section of the pealed. Code of Public Local Laws, of article fourteen, relating to Chestertown, and the authority of the commissioners of said town, to make by-laws, to restrain disorders and disturbances, and prevent and remove all nuisances, to impose fines, forfeitures and penalties, and to collect the same before a Justice of the Peace, as small debts, and that section fifty-six of said article, for the appointment of a Supervisor to repair the streets and alleys and public roads leading from said town, be and the same are hereby repealed, and that the following sections be enacted as substitutes therefor, and

made a part of said Local Laws.

Sec. 42. The said commissioners may make Ordinances of by-laws for the regulation and for regulation such ordinances or by-laws for the regulation and of town. good government of said town and the inhabitants thereof, to restrain disorders and disturbances, and prevent and remove all nuisances within said town, as to them or a majority of them may seem proper, not inconsistent with the laws of this State; and may enforce the observance thereof Penalties: under such penalties, fines and forfeitures as they shall deem proper, not exceeding ten dollars for any one offence, and all such fines, penalties, and forfeitures may be recovered before a Justice of the Peace, by warrant, judgment, and commitment to the public prison of Kent county, in the same manner that commitments are made for fines imposed by the Circuit Courts of this State, on conviction for misdemeanor; but the said commission-Power to re-

ers or a majority of them, shall have power at any mit penalties.
