

CHAPTER 15.

Passed Jan. 29, 1866. AN ACT to make valid certain bequests in the last will and testament of Anna Shultz, late of Washington county, deceased.

Made valid. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the bequest made by Anna Shultz, late of Washington county, deceased, in her last will and testament, dated the tenth day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, to certain persons therein named, for the use and benefit of the Congregation of the Evangelical Lutheran Church, of the town of Jerusalem, commonly called "Funkstown," in said county, be and the same is hereby rendered valid.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 16.

Passed Jan. 29, 1866. AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay Thomas E. Dell for supplemental Codes purchased by the State Librarian, in accordance with Joint Resolution Number One, January Session, eighteen hundred and sixty-five.

Sum appropriated. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of twenty-two hundred dollars, (\$2,200,) be, and the same is hereby appropriated, out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury, to pay Thomas E. Dell for supplemental Codes, purchased by the State Librarian in accordance with Joint Resolution, Number One, January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, and the Treasurer will pay, upon the warrant of the Comptroller of the Treasury, to Thomas E. Dell, or order, the above sum.
