

LAWS OF MARYLAND.

CHAPTER 131.

Passed Feb. 7, 1866. AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to the Union Orphan Asylum of Baltimore city.

Authorized to draw warrant SECTION. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be, and he is hereby authorized and required to draw his warrant on the Treasurer of the State, for the sum of five thousand dollars, in favor of the Union Orphan Asylum of Baltimore city.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect and be in force from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 132.

Passed Feb. 7, 1866. AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to the Children's Aid Society, of Baltimore.

Authorised to pay. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer shall, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, pay to the Treasurer of the Children's Aid Society of Baltimore, the sum of one thousand dollars.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
