

Sec. 9. *And be it enacted*, That all the property of the institution hereby incorporated shall be exempted from all taxation as long as it is used for the charitable purposes hereinbefore mentioned; and the right of the General Assembly to repeal this act, or any part of it, is hereby expressly reserved.

(CHAPTER 157.

AN ACT to provide for the General Valuation and Assessment of property in this State. Passed Feb. 5, 1866.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That all property, real, personal and mixed, of all kinds and description whatever, in this State, shall be liable to valuation and assessment, and shall be chargeable with taxes according to the provisions of this act.

Property declared liable to valuation and assessment.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That to facilitate and expedite the assessments, Baltimore city shall be divided into five Assessment Districts, upon the basis of the present division of the city into wards, whereof wards numbers one, two, three and four shall constitute the First District; and wards numbers five, six, seven and eight shall constitute the Second District; and wards numbers nine, ten, eleven and twelve shall constitute the Third District; and wards numbers thirteen, fourteen, fifteen and sixteen shall constitute the Fourth District; and wards numbers seventeen, eighteen, nineteen and twenty shall constitute the Fifth District. Baltimore county shall be divided into five Assessment Districts, whereof Election Districts numbered one, two and thirteen shall constitute the First District; Election Districts numbered four, eight, and ten shall constitute the Second District; Election Districts numbered five, six and seven shall constitute the Third District; and Election Districts numbered three and nine shall constitute the Fourth
