AN ACT to provide for the General Valuation and Passed Feb. Assessment of property in this State.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Property of Maryland, That all property, real, personal and ble to valuamixed, of all kinds and description whatever, in tion and asthis State, shall be liable to valuation and assess-sessment. ment, and shall be chargable with taxes according to the provisions of this act.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That to faciliate and expedite the assessments, Baltimore city shall be vided.

Baltimore expedite and baltimore city shall be vided. divided into five Assessment Districts, upon the basis of the present division of the city into wards. whereof wards numbers one, two, three and four shall constitute the First District; and wards numbers five, six, seven and eight shall constitute the Second District; and wards numbers nine, ten, eleven and twelve shall constitute the Third District; and wards numbers thirteen, fourteen, fifteen and sixteen shall constitute the Fourth District; and wards numbers seventeen, eighteen, nineteen and twenty shall constitute the Fifth District.
