Sec. 11. And be it enacted, That if any person shall wilfully refuse, or after twenty days notice, neglect or reshall neglect to render any such statement or ac-der account count of his or her property or effects, or any part of property to thereof, as by this Act he or she is required, upon Assessor. the requisition of the Assessors of the proper assessment district, he or she shall forfeit a sum not less than fifty nor more than five hundred dollars, and the said Assessors shall thereupon, upon their own knowledge, and on the best information they can obtain, value the property of such person to the utmost sum they believe the same to be worth in cash, and in their returns of said valuation they shall certify the refusal or neglect of the owner of such property, and the County Commissioners of the county or the Board of Control and Review of Baltimore city, as the case may be, shall assess such person according to the sum so returned, and
