

## CHAPTER 161.

AN ACT for the benefit of the Rev. John Gloyd, <sup>Passed Feb. 7, 1866.</sup>  
 as pastor of the Roman Catholic Church in the  
 city of Westminster, in the State of Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That William A. McKellip, the executor of the last will and testament of Christopher Roney, may, and he is hereby authorized and empowered to pay and advance agreeably to the said last will and testament, unto the Rev. John Gloyd, as Pastor of the Roman Catholic Church in the city of Westminster, in the State of Maryland, the legacy, devise and bequest, given and bequeathed to him by the said Christopher Roney, in and by his last will and testament, and also is authorized to permit him to take, have and enjoy, and use the same to every intent or purpose, agreeably to the said last will and testament; and that the said Rev. John Gloyd; Pastor as aforesaid, be, and he is hereby authorized to take, have and receive, and to demand, sue for and recover, in any court of law or equity, in this State, the said bequest, gift and devise, made and given to him as Pastor of said Church, in and by the said last will and testament of the said Christopher Roney. <sup>Authorized to receive bequests.</sup>

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. <sup>In force.</sup>

## CHAPTER 162.

AN ACT to incorporate the "Union Soldiers Home of Maryland." <sup>Passed Feb. 7, 1866.</sup>
