

- No. 153. An Act to incorporate the Baltimore and Southern Steam Transportation Company.
- No. 154. An Act to amend the Act of eighteen hundred and twenty-six, chapter one hundred and twenty-three, entitled, an Act to incorporate the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company.
- No. 155. An Act to authorize the Governor, Comptroller and Treasurer to sell two hundred shares of the stock of the Union Manufacturing Company, held by the State, and to apply the proceeds to the liquidation of the debts of the State.
- No. 156. An Act to establish the Maryland Industrial School for Girls.
- No. 157. An Act to provide for the general valuation and assessment of property in this State.
