CHAPTER 46.

Passed Feb. 8, 1866. AN ACT to authorize the Governor of the State,
and the Comptroller and Treasurer to convey to
the United States of America, the Government
House and Grounds belonging to this State,
in the City of Annapolis, and to procure other
site and buildings in lieu thereof.

Authorised to convey. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly
of Maryland*, That the Governor, Comptroller and
Treasurer, of this State, be and they are hereby
authorized to convey to the United State of America,
as an addition to the site of the Naval School at
Annapolis, by deed duly executed, acknowledged
and recorded, on such terms and for such consider-
