537. The offices of the Board of Road Directors and of the County Roads Engineer of Allegany County are hereby abolished and all the rights, powers, obligations, functions and duties conferred by law upon the said Board of Road Directors and the said County Roads Engineer are hereby transferred to the Board of County Commissioners of said County and shall hereafter be exercised by and performed by the said Board of County Commissioners to the same extent as if said Board of County Commissioners had been named in the provisions of this Article or any Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland as the body upon which the said rights, powers, obligations, functions and duties were conferred. The salaries of the respective Road Directors for Allegany County shall be paid until the end of the term for which they were elected in 1930.

All the records, papers, documents and property in the possession or under the control of the said Board of Road Directors or of the County Roads Engineer shall be transferred and delivered to the Board of County Commissioners immediately upon the taking effect of this Act.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.

## CHAPTER 575.
