

## CONTINGENT SPECIAL APPROPRIATION

For interest and redemption of such notes, bonds or other evidences of indebtedness, if any, as may be issued by the State Roads Commission under the provisions of House Bill No. 96, this appropriation being contingent (1) upon the passage of said bill and its approval by the Governor, and contingent, also (2) upon the Governor's approval of any issue of notes, bonds or evidences of indebtedness under House Bill No. 96, if enacted; this appropriation to be available, subject to the above contingencies, without regard to the reversion provisions contained in the item for Maintenance and Reconstruction in the budget of the State Roads Commission, and provided further that the reversion provisions governing this appropriation shall not apply to this increased revenue from trucks under any condition; this appropriation being estimated at approximately \$500,000.

## CHAPTER 598

AN ACT to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to sundry gifts, bequests and devises contained in the Last Wills and Testaments of certain persons, deceased, and also to certain gifts, grants, sales, leases and deeds made by various persons to and for the use and benefit of sundry ministerial persons, religious corporations, vestries, educational and charitable institutions, churches, denominations or sects hereinafter named:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction and consent of the said General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby declared, given and granted to the following gifts, bequests, devises, grants, sales, leases, conveyances and deeds, to and from certain persons and bodies corporate to and for the use of certain ministerial persons, religious and educational corporations, orders, denominations and sects, and to certain charitable institutions hereinafter named as herein set forth:

1. To the conveyance of a lot of ground containing 4.26 acres of land, more or less, from Joseph A. Kahler and Elizabeth B. Kahler, his wife, to the Har Zion Congregation, a body corporate; said deed bearing date July 8, 1931, and recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore County in Liber L. McL. M. No. 881, folio 257, etc.
