

19. To Deed from Clara A. Schueler to The Trustees of Appold Methodist Episcopal Church, dated June 19, 1924, and recorded among the said Land Records in Liber S. C. L. No. 4216, folio 166, etc., conveying the ground rent of the above described lot.

20. To an agreement between John C. Toben and Alice Toben, his wife, and The Trustees of Appold Methodist Episcopal Church, dated July 31st, 1924, and recorded among said Land Records in Liber S. C. L. No. 4251, folio 254, etc., being an agreement restricting the erection of a building nearer than six feet to the premises of said Trustees.

21. To the bequest of \$500.00 to the Trustees of the Eutaw Place Baptist Church of Baltimore contained in the Last Will and Testament of Georgia G. Bright, which Will is dated January 16, 1930, and recorded among the records of the Register of Wills for Baltimore City in Wills Liber E. R. D. No. 168, folio 273, etc.

22. To the bequest of \$1,000.00 to the Grace Reformed Church of Frederick contained in the Last Will and Testament of Bertha M. Blum, of Frederick County, deceased, which Will is dated November 21, 1932, and probated December 3, 1932, and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills of Frederick County in Liber M. F. S. No. 1, folio 116.

23. To the devise and bequest of Miss Grace Potterfield to the Frederick Presbyterian Church, as follows:

Item 3. I hereby give, devise and bequeath to the Trustees of the Frederick Presbyterian Church, a body corporate of Frederick County, having its place of worship in Frederick City, all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate left after the payment of the foregoing legacies, absolutely;

the said Will being dated February 27, 1930, and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County in Liber M. F. S. No. 1, folio 67.

24. To the bequest of \$500.00 to the Trustees of Deer Creek Methodist Protestant Church, Incorporated (to be used in the preservation and upkeep of the Cemetery at and adjoining said Church in the Third Election District
