the legacy being Three hundred dollars (\$300.00). One hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) was paid in settlement of this bequest.

- 49. To the gift, grant, devise and bequest of Elizabeth J. Bancroft of Baltimore County, Maryland, of Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) unto Mrs. Ada J. Lee, of the Lee Memorial Mission, Calcutta, India, for missionary purposes, which legacy was paid in the year 1928 by delivery to Mrs. Lee of nine shares of the Preferred Stock of the United States Gypsum Company:
- 50. To the gift, grant, devise and bequest by Rosabella Cooper Sadtler unto the Board of Foreign Missions of the Methodist Episcopal Church, the sum of Five hundred dollars (\$500.00). This bequest being paid June 8, 1921. This Will was probated in Baltimore County, Maryland.
- 51. To the gift, grant, devise and bequest by Martha Washington Gisriel and William Gisriel, her husband, of Baltimore, Maryland, unto the Board of Foreign Missions of the Methodist Episcopal Church, a piece of property on the west side of Holliday Street at the distance of two bundred sixty-seven feet southerly from the southwest corner of Holliday and Pleasant Streets, and running southerly on Holliday Street in the City of Baltimore, twenty feet, with an even width for a depth of ninety feet. Said grant being set out in a Deed dated the 29th day of December in the year 1917, and duly recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore City.
- 52. To the following bequests contained in the Last Will and Testament and Codicil thereto of Annie Horisberg Nuitz, late of Baltimore City, Maryland, deceased, which Will is dated January 13, 1931, and which Codicil is dated January 26, 1932, and recorded among the Will Records of Baltimore City in Liber E. R. D. No. 169, folio 481, etc.:
- (a) The sum of \$3,000.00 (reduced by codicil of \$2,000.00) unto The Fidelity Trust Company, Baltimore, Maryland, its successors or assigns, as Trustee, in trust, nevertheless, to receive the same and to collect the income therefrom and after the payment of all expenses incident to the management of the trust estate, including reasonable compensation to the Trustee, to pay the net income therefrom unto The Calvary English Evangelical Lutheran Church, now located at Payson Street and North Avenue,
