79. To the legacy to the Convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church of the Diocese of Maryland for the use of the Pro Cathedral in Baltimore, contained in the Last Will and Testament of James B. Green, late of Frederick County, Maryland.

80. To the legacy and following ground rents to the Protestant Episcopal Church of the Diocese of Maryland, contained in the Last Will and Testament of Emilla Mather, which Will is now of record in the office of the Register of Wills of Baltimore City in Wills Liber H. W. J. No. 129, folio 365:

(a) Annual ground rents of \$39.00 each; issuing out of the properties known as Nos. 33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 47 East Randall Street.

(b) Annual ground rents of \$41.38 issuing out of the property known as No. 51 Randall Street.

(c) Annual ground rent of \$42.00 each, issuing out of the properties known as Nos. 1152, 1154, 1156 South Scott Street.

(d) Annual ground rent of \$120.00, issuing out of the property No. 2833 Raynor Avenue.

(e) Annual ground rent of \$90.00 issuing out of the property known as 32 South Fulton Street.

All of said rents being in the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland.

81. To the following bequests contained in the Last Will and Testament of William C. Aughinbaugh, deceased, of record in Wills Liber 16, folio 542, one of the record books in the office of the Register of Wills of Washington County:

(a) Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to the Washington County Hospital Association under the provisions set forth in paragraph thirteen of said Will.

(b) One thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) to the Zion Reformed Church of Hagerstown under the provisions set forth in paragraph fourteen of said Will.

(c) One thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) to the Zion Reformed Church of Hagerstown under the provisions set forth in paragraph fifteen of said Will.
