

to be paid by the County Commissioners for Talbot County in equal quarterly installments and shall be paid in full compensation for services required of him under this Act; and no Justice of the Peace so selected for Police Justice shall be permitted to charge any fee or receive any gratuity for making any commitment, granting any release or for the performance of any duty required by law in criminal cases or when acting as coroner; but the said County Commissioners shall in no case pay the aforesaid salary until the said Police Justice shall at first file with the County Commissioners of Talbot County his quarterly report, verified by oath or affirmation, accounting for all fines, forfeitures and penalties imposed by him under the laws of this State or any ordinances of the Town of Oxford, which said report shall show the names of the parties, the fines and penalties imposed, together with the amount of costs, and to whom said costs were due, and the said Police Justice shall at the time of filing said report and as a part of said report pay over to the said County Commissioners the amount of all fines, penalties, forfeitures so received by him which shall be applied by the County Commissioners to the payment of all fees in criminal cases chargeable against said County Commissioners; provided that all fines or penalties imposed for violation of any ordinances of the Town of Oxford shall be paid over to the Commissioners of said town.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all of the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 74.

AN ACT to repeal Sections 326 and 327 of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Talbot County," sub-title "Orphans' Court," and to enact in lieu thereof a new section to be known as Section 326, relating to the compensation of the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Talbot County.
