The County Commissioners of Talbot County hereafter elected or appointed shall each receive in lieu of the per diem and mileage provided in Section 65, an annual salary of six hundred and fifty dollars (\$650.00) payable quarterly, and all necessary traveling expenses when traveling on county business outside of the county.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.

## CHAPTER 79.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 552 of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Caroline County," sub-title "Sheriff," decreasing the amount to be paid for boarding prisoners at the County Jail.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 552 of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Caroline County," sub-title "Sheriff," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, to read as follows:

552. The Sheriff of Caroline County shall be allowed a sum not exceeding forty cents a day for boarding and keeping each prisoner committed to his custody, and the said Sheriff is hereby required to keep a book at the jail, in which he shall record the name of each prisoner committed to his custody, and by what authority, the time when received and the offense charged, and also the date of his discharge, which book shall be open to the inspection of the County Commissioners, State's Attorney and grand jury; should the Sheriff neglect or refuse to keep said book or comply with any of the duties which he is hereby required to perform, he shall be liable to indictment and upon conviction be fined a sum not exceeding one hundred (\$100.00) dollars.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.
