

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is an emergency law necessary for the immediate preservation of the health and welfare of the residents of the City of Cumberland, and, three-fifths of the members of each House of the General Assembly concurring therein by ye and nay vote, the same shall be effective from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 92.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 330 of the Acts of 1920 so as to provide that the provisions of Article 93 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, fixing the salary of the Judges of the Orphans' Court of the several Counties, shall apply to the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Carroll County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Chapter 330 of the Acts of 1920 be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.

CHAPTER 93.
