

City of Annapolis after five days' notice to him. Said members shall not receive any additional compensation for their services as members of the Board of Directors.

Said Board of Directors shall appoint a collector of the water rents and he shall be the City Treasurer of the City of Annapolis. In addition to his duties as City Treasurer, it shall be his duty to act as clerk and secretary to said Board and he shall further collect all water rents due and owing. He shall receive the compensation of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per annum in addition to his present salary as said City Treasurer; and he shall keep a separate account and set of books in his office and a separate bank account for the money collected as water rent. Said Board of Directors shall also appoint an assistant collector who shall be a resident of the City of Annapolis, and it shall be his duty to assist the collector in the performance of his duties; he shall receive Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00) per annum as compensation for his services.

The said Board of Directors is hereby invested with full and ample power to manage the Annapolis Water Company according to its best judgment, and to adopt and enforce all needful rules and regulations for the government of such employees as it may find necessary and expedient to have, and for the care and physical operation of the plant of the said Water Company in the interests of the health, comfort and proper material requirements of the people of the City of Annapolis, and shall have full charge of the development, maintenance and operations of the plant as a municipal property, and shall have the authority to turn off the water of all delinquents in the payment of their water rents. Provided, however, that the salaries of the members of the said Board of Directors, respectively, and of its employees, shall not be increased over the salaries mentioned herein without the express authority of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis. And provided, further, that no expenditure of money in excess of two thousand dollars, may be made by the said Water Company without the approval of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis being first had and obtained.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act be and they are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.
