SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 526 and 527 of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Garrett County," sub-title "Wild Animals," be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.

CHAPTER 103.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 47A of Article 39 of the Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Tidal Waters," as same was enacted by Chapter 165 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1931, pertaining to fishing with anchored gill nets.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 47A of Article 39 of the Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Tidal Waters," as same was enacted by Chapter 165 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1931, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:

Section 47A. The use of anchored gill nets is hereby prohibited in that area of Chesapeake Bay, which is bounded on the north by a line drawn from Turkey Point on the Eastern Shore to Locust Point on Spesutia Island, and on the south by a line drawn from the mouth of Fairlee Creek in Kent County to Robins Point in Harford County.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That all laws or parts of laws inconsistent with the provisions of this Act be and they are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.
