CHAPTER 106.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 534 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Washington County," sub-title "Jurors," decreasing the compensation to be paid jurors.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 534 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Washington County," sub-title "Jurors," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, to read as follows:

534. The County Commissioners shall levy a sufficient sum, in advance, to pay the jurors attending the Circuit Court, promptly at the close of each jury term thereof. Jurors shall receive three (\$3.00) dollars per day for each and every day they shall attend said Court, in addition to mileage as now provided by law.
