

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and being passed upon a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 108.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 139 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Washington County," sub-title "County Commissioners," decreasing the compensation of the County Commissioners of Washington County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 139 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Washington County," sub-title "County Commissioners," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:

139. The County Commissioners of Washington County hereafter elected to said office shall each receive for their services an annual salary of six hundred dollars (\$600.00), payable in monthly installments.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1935.

CHAPTER 109.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 796 and 797 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Washington
