

the Acts of 1916, known as the Local Option Law for Washington County, and providing for the submission of this Act to the qualified voters of Washington County for adoption or rejection.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 676 to 681, both inclusive, of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Washington County," sub-title "Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks," and Chapter 104 of the Acts of 1916, known as the Local Option Law for Washington County, be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall be submitted to the registered and qualified voters of Washington County, Maryland, at the first state-wide regular or special election to be held in the State of Maryland, and the Supervisors of Elections for Washington County are hereby directed to have printed on the ballots to be used in said election, in clear, plain, bold Roman capital twelve-point type, the title of this Act, below which shall be printed, on separate lines, with a square or box to the right, and opposite, the words "For Repeal of Prohibition and Local Option Laws of Washington County," and a corresponding square or box to the right, and opposite, the words "Against Repeal of Prohibition and Local Option Laws of Washington County." Same to be printed on said ballot so as to give the voter a clear opportunity to designate by a cross (X) mark in a square or box opposite the words "For Repeal of Prohibition and Local Option Laws of Washington County," "Against Repeal of Prohibition and Local Option Laws of Washington County," his answer to such question.

The Supervisors of Elections for Washington County shall give notice, at least fifteen days before the date of said election, by advertisements in two newspapers published in said county, of the submission of said question, provided, that if for any reason said notice shall not be given, or not given in the manner prescribed, it shall not invalidate this Act or prevent its taking effect. The laws in force for conducting of elections and the provisions of the Corrupt Practices Act, shall apply in all particulars to the election held under this Act, except as otherwise provided herein.

The Judges and Supervisors of Elections of said Washington County shall canvass the returns in like manner as
