CHAPTER 128.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 346 and 356 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Prince George's County," sub-title "County Treasurer," decreasing the compensation to be paid to the County Treasurer and reducing the amount allowed for clerk hire in the office of said Treasurer.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 346 and 356 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Prince George's County," sub-title "County Treasurer," be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, to read as follows:

- 346. The Treasurer shall be entitled to appoint such clerk or clerks as he may deem necessary, and for whose official conduct he shall be responsible, said clerk or clerks to be paid by the Treasurer out of the salary provided by law to be paid him as compensation for the discharge of his official duties as the collector of taxes, but in addition thereto the County Commissioners may in their discretion allow and pay over to said Treasurer for additional clerk hire an amount not to exceed in any one year the sum of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$2,700).
- 356. The Treasurer of Prince George's County shall receive in full compensation for the discharge of his official duties as collector of taxes levied for State and county purposes the sum of Five Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$5,400.00) for each year of his term of office, which shall be payable monthly; and shall receive no other compensation for the collection of any taxes whether for State or county purposes.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That the provisions of this Act shall not be construed to affect the compensation of the County Treasurer during his present term, but shall only apply to his successors in office.
- SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.
