lowing the name of the candidate; and immediately under the name of the candidate or candidates for Mayor shall be printed a black line extending to a square on which the voter may insert in writing the name of a candidate for Mayor, if he so desires, which name may not already be printed on the ballot, and also on such ballot shall appear the name or names of the candidate or candidates for Councilmen arranged alphabetically, and immediately following the words "For Councilman," shall be printed on said ballot, and preceding the name or names of the candidate or candidates shall be plainly printed in black ink a direction to the voters "Vote for one by making a cross (X) mark in that square which is opposite the name of the candidate to be voted for," and a black line shall be printed immediately under the name of each candidate extending to a square opposite the name of the candidate and immediately under the names of the candidates or candidate there shall be printed a black line extending to a square on which the voter may insert in writing the name of a candidate for Councilman, if he so desires, which name may not already be printed on the ballot.

There shall be a separate ballot for each ward, and the ballots of no two wards shall be printed on the same color

paper.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.

## CHAPTER 130.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 14, Section 20, Section 29, Section 34, Section 35, Paragraph A of Section 38, Paragraph B of Section 40, Section 56, Paragraph B of Section 59 and Section 73 of Article 99 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1929 Supplement), title "Water Fowl, Birds and Game," subtitles "Hunter's License," "Upland and Migratory Game Birds and Game Animals, Bag Limits and Export of Game," "Song and Insectivorous Birds," "Field Trials," "Waterfowl and Migratory Birds. Use of Boats Prohibited. Blinds," "Susquehanna Flats," "Otter, Muskrat, Raccoon and Opossum," and "Elk and Deer," as said
