(a) The certificates authorized by this section shall expire on the 31st day of December of the year issued, and shall not be transferable.

Section 34. The Game Warden is authorized to grant permits to bona fide Field Trials Clubs and Associations to hold field trials with raccoon or opossum, bird or rabbit dogs in this State any time during the closed season, under such rules and regulations as may be adopted by said Game Warden safe-guarding the interest of the wild-life in this State.

Section 35. It shall be unlawful to hold field trials with dogs in this State during any closed hunting season, unless permission to do so is granted by the Game Warden, and any Club or association holding a field trial during any closed hunting season, shall not be allowed to shoot, or shoot at any game of any species, which are protected by law.

Any person or persons owning any raccoon or opossum, bird or rabbit dog or dogs, who desires to train said dog or dogs during any closed hunting season for the purpose of entering said dog or dogs in any field trial must secure a permit by applying to the Game Warden to train said dog or dogs during any closed hunting season.

Section 38 (a) It shall be unlawful to hunt any wild duck, goose, swan or brant within the limits of the State of Maryland, between the first day of February and the thirty-first day of October, in each and every year, both dates inclusive, and it shall be further unlawful to have in possession any such wild duck, goose, swan or brant between the tenth day of February and the thirty-first day of October in each and every year, and it shall be unlawful to hunt any of the game birds herein mentioned on Sunday. Provided, however, it shall be unlawful to hunt wild water fowl on the waters of the Magothy River and its tributaries in Anne Arundel County on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays during the months of November and December.

And be it further provided that it shall be unlawful to hunt wild water fowl at any time or in any manner on either the land or the waters within the boundary lines of the Blackwater Migratory Bird Refuge located in Dorchester County, or to hunt wild water fowl on either land or water from a blind, or otherwise, within 100 yards of the boundary lines of said refuge.
