

## CHAPTER 147.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 258 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Prince George's County," sub-title "Constables," so as to provide that the constable appointed for each election district of said County shall be a resident of said district.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 258 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Prince George's County," sub-title "Constables," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

258. There shall be one constable for each of the several election districts of Prince George's County; provided that each constable appointed by the County Commissioners of said County shall be a resident of the election district for which he is appointed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1933.

CHAPTER 148.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 200 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Prince George's County," sub-title "Circuit Court," sub-heading "Court Stenographer," as said section was amended by Chapter 336 of the Acts of 1931, decreasing the compensation of the Court Stenographer of Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 200 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Prince George's County," sub-title "Circuit Court," sub-heading "Court Stenographer," as said section was amended by Chapter 336 of the Acts of 1931, be, and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:
